



MEET MICKEY CROYLE

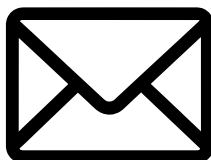
“

In 1960, I began to accompany my grandfather to work at the Brookville Water Works during Holidays learning about water treatment, water quality and the impacts of strip mining, lumber, flooding and storm runoff. Since then, I have become an environmental advocate and spent 40 years with the League of Women Voters, 46 with the Sierra Club, and 9 with the Missouri Coalition for the Environment. I have lived in Brookville, PA, Seneca Falls, NY, Keuka Park, NY, Iowa City, Iowa, San Francisco, CA, Cincinnati OH and Saint Louis MO.

League Experiences in both Cincinnati and St Louis included serving several terms as Director on Board/Ed Fund and representing the League on various coalition environmental groups. In 2018 I led the Missouri Study of the US Agriculture Position Update that did include the concern for MO and IA of the Concentrated Animal Feed Operations and genetically modified organism (both animal and seeds).

During my professional career as a research scientist and later as a health physicist I also served as my department's sustainability representative both at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine and at Washington University in St Louis.
